Dear parents and carers,

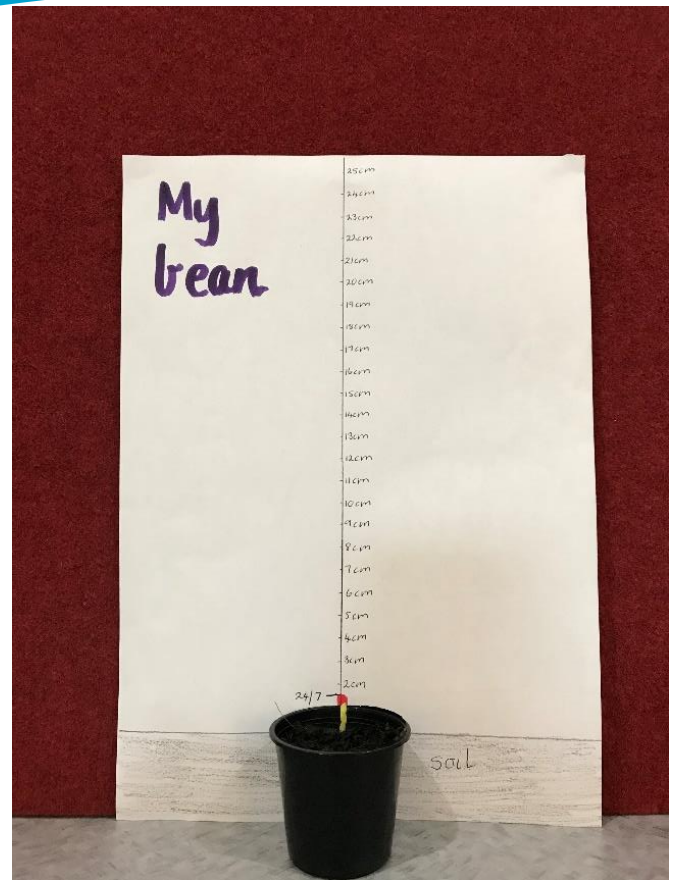
Congratulations on completing Week 1 of Remote Learning.
